 - c. Park Bench Project – Before moving forward with this project, Deb Noone will confirm specifics with Duane Freed.
 - d. Monthly Eco Tips for FB posts – Andrea Glang is working on posts.
 - e. EAC session for children attending the township summer camp – Lurleen Worthington and JP Johnson agreed to work on this project. Deb Noone will determine date and time with Duane Freed.
 - f. Native and Invasive Plant Projects – Andrea Glang will be working on this. Deb will reach out and invite the Eagle Scout, who is planting a native plant garden, to the January or February EAC meeting. Andrea Glang also suggested a Milkweed Seed event in January. She will do the research on holding the event and costs associated with it. Deb Noone will talk to Duane Freed about getting a room for the event.
