The EAC welcomed Ms. Worthington and Ms. Noone, both of whom are new members. The members gave introductions and Ms. Sreenivasan then informed Ms. Worthington and Ms. Noone about current and upcoming projects, including the Reusable Bag Project.

Reusable Bag Project: Mr. Johnson will follow up with bag vendors on an exact date for recipience of the bags.

Stream Cleaning Initiative: Ms. Sreenivasan informed Ms. Worthington and Ms. Noone on the stream cleaning initiative, which was initially suggested by the supervisors. Ms. Sreenivasan then asked Ms. Noone and Ms. Worthington if they had ideas for locations to conduct the stream cleaning. Ms. Noone suggested a region on her property that connects to the north branch of Neshaminy Creek. Mr. Liechtenstein recommended using the Bucks County GIS to analyze property lines—ensuring that suggested regions are not on private property. Ms. Sreenivasan will connect with Angela to determine restrictions on the stream clean-up, as well as if a training video is needed to proceed. Members proposed the September 7<sup>th</sup> or August 17<sup>th</sup> date tentatively.

Upcoming Newsletter: Mr. Vaidyanath will draft an article for the upcoming Newsletter, potentially including a tribute to the late Tom Lurz.
