DEAR Stacey Mulholland,

The Safe Drinking Water Act requires any person that operates a public water system test the water for certain contaminants on a routine basis and issue public notification to the consumers whenever the water fails to meet Pennsylvania standards or whenever there is a failure to have the testing or reporting performed on time or correctly. A review of our records indicates that you have failed to have certain water tests performed, or your laboratory has not submitted the test results to the Department accurately or timely or you have failed to submit accurate required reports or forms.
